OTHER LITIGATION:

There is currently a Complaint for Divorce filed in the Circuit Court of the Eighteenth Judicial District Circuit in and for SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA, CASE NO: 2015-DR-1940. There is also currently pending a Motion to Dismiss for lack of jurisdiction in the same case. In the last 6 years, the children have resided with the Plaintiff and Defendant at 7766 Phantom Dr. Milligton, TN.38053 and 3401 Sterling lake Circle, Oviedo, Florida 32765.

2. Plaintiff would aver that although the parties separated in May, 2015 in Seminole County, FL, she has lived in the State of Tennessee, with the minor children for the previous six years. Defendant is reserve duty military personnel, and, as such, is afforded all of the rights and privileges provided by the Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 1940 (now the Service Members' Civil Relief Act), USCA APP. §501 et. seq.

3. Plaintiff would aver that irreconcilable differences exist between the parties and the marriage has been irretrievably broken. In the alternative, Plaintiff would aver that the Defendant is guilty of inappropriate marital conduct.

4. During their marriage, the parties have accumulated certain items of property. Further, various marital debts and obligations have been incurred by the parties. Plaintiff would aver that it would be proper for the Court to approve any agreement entered into between the parties concerning the marital properties, debts and obligations, or, in the event of a failure of the parties so to agree, for the Court to adjudicate the respective rights and interests of each party in making an equitable division of said property.

5. Plaintiff would aver that she is a fit and proper parent to exercise custody over

the minor child with the Defendant to have all reasonable and liberal co-parenting time, considering all present circumstances. Plaintiff requests the Court to approve any agreement entered into between the parties concerning a Parenting Plan, or, in the event they are unable to reach such an agreement, to adjudicate the respective rights of the parties considering the best interests of the minor child.

6. Plaintiff would aver that the Defendant shall be responsible for a reasonable and fair amount of child support for the support and maintenance of the parties' minor children, said child support to be in compliance with the Tennessee State Child Support Guidelines.

7. Considering all statutory factors, Plaintiff would aver that she is a proper candidate for the granting of spousal support herein, both *pendente lite*, and transitional.

PREMISES CONSIDERED, PLAINTIFF PRAYS:

1. That service of process be made upon the Defendant, and that he be required to answer hereto, but not under oath, his oath to same being hereby expressly waived.

2. That upon the hearing of this cause, the Plaintiff be granted an absolute divorce and that the parties be restored to all the rights and privileges of unmarried persons.

3. That the Plaintiff be awarded an equitable division and portion of the property accumulated during the term of the marriage.

4. That the Court immediately grant temporary custody of the minor children to the Plaintiff, and that, upon the hearing of this cause, the Court designate the Plaintiff as the primary residential parent with the Defendant to have all reasonable and liberal Co-parenting time, considering the present circumstances.


5. That the Defendant be responsible for a reasonable amount of child support for the support and maintenance of the parties' minor children, in compliance with the Tennessee Child Support Guidelines, with the Court to set an immediate child support hearing *pendente*

lite.


6. That the Plaintiff be awarded her attorney fees incurred herein and all costs of litigation hereto.

7. That the Court immediately hold an alimony *pendente lite* hearing and grant temporary spousal support to the Plaintiff, and further grant transitional alimony upon the hearing of this cause.

8. That the Plaintiff have such other, further and general relief to which she may show herself entitled upon the hearing of this cause.
